
- Frank Shepard Fairey
- Born 1970 in South Carolina
- Rhode Island School of Design, Illustration
- Became involved with art in 84' designing skateboards and T-shirts

Worldwide Propaganda Delivery

- Started off making stencils and stickers
- Underground community
- Increasingly became more well known
- Widely known in 2008 Presidential election

Andre the Giant Has a Posse

- First well known street art and viral marketing campaign created in 1989 among skateboarding community
- "an experiment in phenomenology"
- Community creates own variants







- Obey Giant was intended to inspire curiosity and cause the masses to question their relationship with their surrounding

- 1,000,000 stickers









Design

- Propaganda-style
- Uses lots of red, yellow, black
- Clean, Organized, Simplistic
- Patterns, Repetition

Social Change

- Guerrilla marketing: advertising strategy in which low-cost unconventional means are utilized to convey or promote an idea
- "Obey cured all my obedience problems"
- LOTS of stickers, stencils, wheat paste
- Repetition of images

Controversy

- Accused of stealing images
- Politically opinionated activism
- Obama Photo
- "Legal" street art
- MOCA
- Arrested 16 times

Youth Influence

- Street art aesthetic appeals to younger audiences
- Greatly influences the youth with powerful designs, slogans, and methods
- Long successful street art career carried followers for electing Obama
